

FUFC Photo Declaration



Occasionally, we may take photographs of the children at our games or club events. We may use these images in our club brochure or in other printed publications that we produce, as well as on our website. We may also make video or webcam recordings for monitoring or other educational use.

Photographs or film footage by parents or guardians of their children at club events is permitted under an exemption in the Data Protection Act 1998. There is also a journalistic exemption with regard to the media and occasionally your Child's images may appear in local or national newspapers, or on televised news programmes. Please indicate if you do not wish your child to appear in the media, and we will try to keep your child out of the photographs.

To comply with the Data Protection Act 1998, we need your permission before we can photograph or make any recordings of your child.

We would like your permission to:

1. Use your child's photograph in the club Brochure and other printed publications which we produce for promotional purposes?
2. Use your child's image on our website?
3. Let your child appear on Webcam?
4. Use your child's image on video.
5. Let your child's image appear in the media?

Please note that websites can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom.

This form is valid for the period of time that your child attends this club. Consent will automatically expire after this time.

- We will not use the personal details or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child or adult in a photographic image on video, on our website, in our school brochure or in any of our other printed publications.

We will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on video, on our website, in our club prospectus or in any other printed publications. If we use photographs of individual pupils, we will not use the name of that child in the accompanying text or photo caption.

If we name a pupil in the text, we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article.

We may include pictures of pupils and club members that have been drawn by your child.

We may use group or activity photographs or footage with very general labels, such as “game Vs Hampton Blue” or “Xmas Party”.

We will only use images of children who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.

FOR INFORMATION

The Club may have to place a ban on parents using cameras and video equipment at Club events (ie. games, club events, presentation, etc), if not all parents give their consent on the “Images of Children Agreement”.
